Happy Birthday, Feral Cat FOCUS Inc. We are celebrating 20 Years!



And almost 40,000 feral and free roaming 'Community' cats have been Trap/Neutered/vaccinated/Returned (TNVR) from our inception in 2003.

Three volunteers, literally sitting at their kitchen tables, have made this a reality. And then all our fabulous dedicated people who embraced the mission, and who's unequal selflessness, and love for the animals with no voice, made it their voice!

Feral Cat FOCUS is now 84 members strong, each volunteer doing one single job or several different jobs. From Linen cutting, to trapping to phones to transporting to shelter making to feral cat holding and care, to administrative. We do it all with an all-volunteer group of caring individuals.



It is raining Feral Kittens







We know everyone wants the kittens that are born to feral cats to find an inside home, sitting under a fan in the summer, or in front of a fireplace in the winter, but it isn't realistic. There just are not enough homes for them all! So, our theory at Feral Cat FOCUS is that there is NOTHING wrong with leaving the kittens with their mom, and when they get old enough alter them and they can live with their 'colony family'. Just ensure they get the fundamental services they need as 'Community Cats'. We also have two expert Councilors on our staff that can help anyone socialize feral kittens, and we have a list of rescue groups that might be able to help you place them into an adoption agency.

- Remember the only way to socialize feral kittens is to get them young enough, anything over 10 weeks requires more patience and time,
- Keep them crated, and all the rescue groups require that they can be picked up and held. Otherwise, alter them and leave them with the colony.
- TIME, PATIENCE, and remember do not start to socialize if you cannot follow through!

DOES YOUR FERAL CAT COLONY NEED A DRY or WARM WINTER SHELTER or TWO?

Feral Cat FOCUS is starting to build shelters in May and we are already receiving requests even though winter (fortunately) is many months away. Last year we built over 115 shelters for our community cats and the demand is growing every year.

Unfortunately, we have had to increase the cost to \$23.00 per shelter to try and cover the increasing cost of materials. Shelters consist of two Sterilite/Rubbermaid bins, one inside the other, with an entrance and exit. They are insulated with Styrofoam, insulation material, and straw.

If you are interested in a cat shelter, please call 716.515.8965 and leave a message with your name and phone number. Someone will get back to you and we will reserve a shelter for you. We will have pickup available at two locations (North Towns and South Towns). Thank you for caring!

Feeding/Care instructions for Feral/Free-Roaming Cats.

- **No Ground feeding**! Food should never be thrown on the ground and scattered all over.
- Cats should only be feed once a day, working around your schedule, keeping to the same time every day, so that the cats can rely on their daily feeding. *They will adjust for your timing.*
- Food should never be left out all day.
- **NEVER** feed at night!
- Food should be placed in a dish and picked up after each feeding. **NO DISHES ARE TO BE LEFT OUT**. Always keep the feeding areas clean, and neat.
- If there is a garage, barn, shed, porch, try feeding the cats in an enclosed area, where you will not be annoying your neighbors. Again, feed only once a day. Keep areas clean.
- Water can be left out. And in Winter try using heated water bowls. A pinch of sugar in the water will help it from freezing.
- Also heated pads can be used, they only heat up when an animal sits on them. Look for them on Amazon. (Under \$30.00) Recommended/used by horse stables, and animal barns. Try to provide shelters for the cats. Go to our website <u>www.feralcatfocus.org</u> for feeding and warming shelters, as well as more ideas for caring for feral/free-roaming cats. Never use blankets as the fibers get wet and freeze. Straw is a great insulator.

These feeding instructions are accepted by most municipalities and the Erie County Health Department.


