## The Humane Trapping of Free-Roaming Cats Will Occur

If healthy feral or free-roaming cats are trapped they will be taken to a veterinarian to be spayed or neutered and vaccinated. They will then be returned to this location where a feral cat caregiver will provide food, water, and shelter. Friendly trapped cats may be placed for adoption.

- **KEEP YOUR PET CATS INSIDE** on the above dates so they won't be inadvertently trapped.
- **<u>DO NOT FEED THE OUTDOOR CATS</u>** on above dates. Please withhold all food (soft, dry, treats, etc.) no food whatsoever should be provided to the outdoor cats.
- **CONTINUE TO PROVIDE DRINKING WATER**. This ensures the cats are hungry enough to enter traps.
- **DO NOT DROP OFF CATS!** Animal abandonment is illegal and punishable. If you can no longer care for your cat, contact a local animal humane organization.
